



Zero Tolerance Sideline Behavior Policy

UC Premier Parent Code of Conduct Specific Points

- When you registered your player for the year you signed the UC Premier Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct in order to complete the process. There are some points that are clearly laid out and you are expected to follow them if you are to be allowed to sit on the sideline or for your player to continue to play with the club. Due to recent events we are reviewing the following points and requiring all parents within the club to initial and sign the following document and return back to coach **before** players are allowed to take the field in game play following the team meeting in which this form is distributed. If you cannot abide by the following conduct outlined, we respectfully request you observe the game from the parking lot and refrain from participating on the sidelines.
- #5 states: "I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating **positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators** at every game, practice or other sporting event."
- #14 states: "I will **respect the officials and their authority** during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches **at the game field**, and will take time to speak **with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.**"
 - (**PLEASE NOTE: Team Chat is not an appropriate platform to discuss issues or problems.)
- #16 states: "I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team."
- **Consequences:**
 - Your player will be benched by the coach for a period of time or the remainder of the match. The timing is coaches discretion. _____ (initial)
 - If you continue your player will not be allowed to finish the game but is required to remain on the sideline and participate with the team for post game chat and team sportsmanship exchanges. _____ (initial)
 - Parent will be required to complete a PCA course before they are allowed to return to the sideline. A 1-3 game suspension of the parent may be enforced. _____ (initial)
 - If parent doesn't complete the course or respect the suspension their player will be released from the club. _____ (initial)
